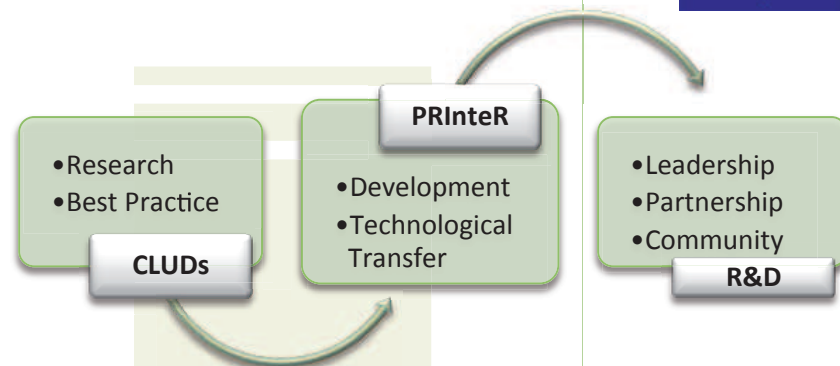




## The first institutional Workshop
